



# Courses for Homeschoolers

## Elementary

2018-19

Our Elementary program is designed in such a way that several areas of instruction intertwine throughout a student's day. For example, our Language Arts curriculum will be utilized several times a day while students engage in our spelling exercises as well as reading samples for our Bible or Social Studies lessons. Therefore, not all subject areas are conducive to Homeschool student participation. There are, however, many opportunities within our special classes, and a few academic subjects within our upper elementary for homeschooled students to participate.

#### **Gym (Grades 3-5) .4 credit course**

Students have gym class twice a week for 38 minutes each session. Age appropriate skills are taught while students learn various athletic games and exercises.

#### **Music (Grades 3-5) .2 credit course**

Music class is taught once a week for a 38 minute session. Highly participatory instruction is given at each grade level on the basics of music. Students are taught to read music and understand rhythm. The goal of this class is to instill not only music knowledge, but a love for music arts.

#### **Art (Grades 3-5) .2 credit course**

Art class is taught once a week for a 38 minute session. Students learn to create art in various mediums, while instruction is given in color, perspective, and technique.

#### **Choir (Grades 4-5) .2 credit course**

Choir practices once a week for a 38 minute session. Students learn harmony and technique while practicing songs that will be performed at the Christmas Concert in December, and the Spring Concert in May.

#### **Band (Grade 5) .5 credit course**

Our Elementary Band meets once a week for a 76 minute session. There is also a separate lesson time for various instrument groups. The band practices songs for the Christmas Concert in December, and the Spring Concert in May.

#### **Social Studies (Grades 5) 1 credit course**

Class meets four days a week for a 38 minute session. This Social Studies course focuses on US History and geography, encouraging students to grow in their Biblical worldview.

#### **Science (Grades 5) 1 credit course**

Class meets four days a week for a 38 minute session. This Science course is an overview of life science, physical science earth/space science, and the human body. The experiments lead students to investigate, observe, and learn about the world around them with an emphasis on God's design and purpose in His creation.
